Triton's Trumpet2024 Rules & Regulations

Owners, owners' guests, and renters are accountable for their behavior and actions, and responsible for following these rules and regulations. Failure to do so shall result in warnings, sanctions, fines, and suspension of privileges.

Smoking: This is a smoke-free complex. Smoking is prohibited on the grounds, including balconies, except for the designated smoking area. "Smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, burning, holding, or carrying any lighted cigarette, cigar, cigarillo, pipe, or other lighted smoking device for burning tobacco or any other plant product in any manner or in any form. Smoking also includes the use of electronic cigarettes (electronic tobacco delivery systems) and hookahs. The designated smoking area is at the East end (adjacent to Coastal Highway) of the Tritons Trumpet parking lot where the bench is located.

Pool Rules: Renters and guests are required to enter the pool using the key you were issued. NO KEY – NO ENTRANCE. Children in diapers are not allowed in the pool. Beach sand and grit must be rinsed off with hose/shower outside of pool gate prior to entering pool area, elevator, or condos. The police will be called for anyone trespassing when the pool is closed. All pool rules shown here and posted at the pool will be enforced by the pool attendant.

Pets: Only owners on-site are permitted to have pets in condos. Owners' guests and renters are not permitted to have pets on condo property. Pay attention to signs regarding pet walking. Penalties will be assessed for failure to clean up after your pet (OCMD 6-34 (11).

Noise: Keep noise levels down, especially on balconies/patios. No excessive noise from 11PM to 9AM. Ocean City has a strict noise ordinance (OCMD Article V) for noise heard within 50 feet of the premises. At any time, there shall not be excessive dog-barking in a continuous manner causing a disturbance (OCMD Code Sec 6-3).

Decks: No towels, clothing or linens shall be hung from balcony railings. No charcoal or gas grills or open flames (i.e., fire-pits) are allowed. Deck furniture shall be secured at all times.

Shopping Carts: A limited number of carts are for use in the south end stairwell of building A for moving luggage/groceries in and out of condos. Please return carts in an expeditious manner. Carts shall not be left in the entrance hallway of your unit or outdoor walkways.

Bikes: Bikes shall only be stored in a vehicle, condo or on the bike racks.

Parking: Only one reserved spot is provided per condo. Additional parking at spots designated as D and E is available for additional family members and guests.

Parking Lot: No boats, boat trailers, or campers shall be parked in the parking lot at any time. No skateboarding is allowed
